Cost: \$50

This includes taikai fee, bento and tenugui for each participant.

This event will be a team tournament followed by individual divisions and **all participants must be 16 years of age or older.** Each federation or club may enter up to two teams, individuals without teams may be used to backfill teams with less than 5 members. Detailed rules will be posted on www.womenskendo.com. The format of the tournament will be similar to the AUSKF Championships and the FIK Championships. There will also be single elimination individual events for both kyu and dan.

Women's Seminar:

We are unable to offer the week-long seminar prior to the tournament, however, we are able to offer a keiko/informal seminar the day before the taikai, open to ALL ladies, regardless if they plan to enter the tournament or not. We do ask that attendees be 15yrs or older.

Please RSVP on the final sign up submission for your group. **Cost per person is \$35** and includes food, non-alcoholic and some alcoholic drinks.

COVID-19 Information:

At this time, masks are optional in the IMA, this is subject to change per the University of Washington's policies. We will send out updates as we get closer to the event and note these policies can be changed up to event day. Proof of vaccination is also not required at this time (be prepared to show it if asked) - it is highly encouraged for your own safety and those that cannot be vaccinated.

Parking, Building & Logistics:

Sunday parking and the University is free - we recommend the largest lot on campus E18 and E1 - just North of the building and soccer fields, with a short walk to the facility. Participants will have full use of the building facilities, including shower, locker room, bathrooms and there is a small cafe in the lobby. The IMA has shorter operating hours on Sundays - doors usually open at 11am (pending the Fall 2022 schedule), which is why the start time is much later than a typical tournament. We will have a break between the team and individual events with a lunch option - but it will also be later than the typical lunch hours as a result of the later start time.
